

FONHHP Resolution 2013-2

Whereas: It is the intent of the Board of Directors to support the Newberry Hill Heritage Park stewardship group in complying with the long range goals established by stakeholders, to wit

“ Celebrate the natural beauty and protect the ecological health of plant/wildlife communities and watershed headwaters”, and

Whereas: Construction of a boardwalk on Bird Meadow Trail will protect the headwater wetland in the east drainage of the park, and

Whereas: Construction of a Wildlife Viewing Platform on Wildlife Trail will protect the shoreline of the Heritage Wetland by acting as a control point for foot traffic drawn to the water’s edge, and

Whereas: The Silverdale Rotary club has agreed to fund purchase of materials for construction of the boardwalk and viewing platform (\$2100.00), and

Whereas: NHHP Stewards have agreed to construct the boardwalk with volunteer labor and equipment and fund the balance of materials costs or overruns, and

Whereas: Kitsap County Parks has approved this project in the 2013 Work Plan and obtained a permit from Kitsap County Department of Community Development for construction of the wildlife viewing platform,

Now therefore be it resolved that: the Board of Directors does task the officers with disbursement of funds by purchasing all necessary building materials for these projects with Rotary funds, and.

Be it further resolved that: the officers ensure that purchase receipts and a record of all purchases will be kept with the treasurer and available for inspection by Silverdale Rotary.
