

## FONHHP Resolution 2013-3

**Whereas:** It is the intent of the Board of Directors to support the Newberry Hill Heritage Park stewardship group's implementation of the Forest Management Plan and,

**Whereas:** this plan is in compliance with the long range goals established by stakeholders, to wit

*“Celebrate the natural beauty and protect the ecological health of plant/wildlife communities and watershed headwaters”, and “maximize the park’s educational potential for students and the larger community in safe and engaging ways” and,*

**Whereas:** Implementation of the Kitsap County Board of Commissioners policy on managing county forestlands has been approved and,

**Whereas:** NHHP Stewards have developed and approved a site specific management plan to implement said policy for Newberry Hill Heritage Park and,

**Whereas:** Public outreach and education on goals and objectives of this plan will be an essential component to its success

**Now therefore be it resolved that:** the Board of Directors tasks the officers , in cooperation with the Kitsap County Forester (Arno Bergstrom), to construct informational kiosks and create and print flyers explaining variable density thinning and its role in restoring complex forest habitats within the park and,

**Be it further resolved that:** once constructed stewards and friends will install kiosks within the park in areas that are appropriate and near areas to be thinned in 2014 and,

**Be it finally resolved that:** the officers ensure that purchase receipts and a record of all purchases will be kept with the treasurer and available for inspection by the board.
